## 1) Evolution of African American Culture

I chose this topic because February is Black History Month in America. Much of the history and lineage of African American was lost due to slavery. Our ancestors were sold into slavery or abducted from their tribal homes. African from various tribes were brought to America and many of them could not even communicate with each other. Consequently, from generation to generation, more and more of our African heritage was lost. The purpose of Black History Month is to educate our youth and the world about the accomplishments

of African thoughtout our history that have often been ignored or attributed to others. Music in today's world has been highly influenced the African American experience, so today I will share some highlights about how the music has envolved.



## 2) The history of Gospel

A common feature of African American songs was the call-and-response format, where a leader would sing a verse or verses and the others would respond with a chorus. This came from African traditions of agricultural work song and found its way into the spirituals that developed once slaves began to convert to Christianity and from there to both gospel music and the blues. Also evident were field hollers, shouts, and moans, which may have been originally designed for different bands or individuals to locate each other and narrative songs that used folk tales and folk motifs, often making use of homemade instruments. In early

slavery drums were used to provide rhythm, but they were banned in later years because of the fear that black slaves would use them to communicate in a rebellion; nevertheless, slaves managed to generate percussion and percussive sounds, using other instruments or their own bodies. Perhaps surprisingly, there are very few examples of work songs linked to cotton picking.

The religious institutions of African American Christians commonly are referred to collectively as the black church. During slavery, many slaves were stripped of their African belief systems and typically denied free religious practice, forced to become Christian. Slaves managed, however, to hang on to some practices by integrating them into Christian worship in secret meetings. These practices, including dance, shouts, African rhythms, and enthusiastic singing, remain a large part of worship in the African American church. African American churches taught that all people were equal in God's



eyes.



3) Gospel Greats

Tomy Dorsey, Mahalia Jackson, Andre Crouch, そして Oh happy day のアレンジャーEdwin Hawkins, Mary Mary 等の人々のスタイルが Gospel music の信条を貫いている一方 Ray Charles, Al Green, Anita Baker 等の人々は African American church のリード歌手からナイトクラブ、ショウビジネスに転身して行った有名人で、いわゆる secular artists で歌詞も微妙に変更している、と分析しています。

4) African American culture has influenced music all over the world.

African American musical styles became an integral part of American popular music through blues, jazz, rhythm and blues, and then rock and roll, soul and hip hop; all of these styles were consumed by Americans of all races, but were created in African American styles and idioms before eventually becoming common in performance and consumption across racial lines.
